







Mediation is an effective interdisciplinary method of dispute resolution, where legal studies, entrepreneurship, administration and psychology converge. In the recent years the EU has embraced this alternative way of dispute settlement for its main characteristics of being time and cost efficient. The applicable legislation - both on a European and national level, has been fully set out to meet those targets. Nowadays it is a high time for academic institutions and mediation training centres to educate students to become professional and experienced mediators who are skilled in mediation techniques.

In September 2016, Turiba University in **cooperation** with 5 partner Universities – University of Genoa (Italy), Mykolas Romeris University (Lithuania), University of National and World Economy (Bulgaria), University of Graz (Austria) and University of Economics, Prague (Czech Republic) started to implement Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership project. This project has gathered experts and professional mediators from 6 countries.



The aim of the project was to create, operate, maintain and integrate in the curriculum of the partnering universities an online educational platform which serve as database of information and materials on mediation. At the moment, the mediation platform is available for any University or training institution which offers the studies of mediation. Anyone is welcome to get acquainted with a large amount of materials gathered about mediation in the partner countries. Moreover, the students are invited to use the developed study materials. Teachers can use the elaborated methodological materials and also become a partner of the platform and involve the students in the international online mediation sessions.
